Wrote a text, "In Praise of Walking", re-conceptualizing walking as a form of rebellion, a manifestation of the subject, who has seen "the possible" in the space and passed from the "virtual" to the "actual".

Proposed a "critical urban practice" that invites participants walking in Başakşehir, the podium of Istanbul's post-2000 urbanization, where the urbanization project of every hegemony period left traces. Organized walks and took part in a documentary film that follows the traces of overlapping strata through anthropogeographic panoramas of the outskirts of the city.

Used the practice of walking as a mode of critical research method and an artistic intervention to demystify the propaganda of the current hegemonic urban agenda.

Participated as an activist in the existing solidarity process of Gülsuyu & Gülensu, once an Alevi ghetto, now an ethnically mixed but organized community that is under the threat of eviction by the neoliberal urban transformation agenda in Istanbul. From 2015 onwards, contributed to making the top-down process deflected into a bottom-up one with a community that has a strong counterhegemonic culture. Facilitated the public participation process of underrepresented local initiatives who moved to the neighborhood due to the government policies of forced evacuation of Kurdish villages in the 90s, and were the subjects of police/military operations after the 1980 coup.

Enabled residents to become familiar with the complex terminology of the previous zoning plan, which produced the inflexible spatial policies that would guide the neighborhood renewal process concretely - translated it or made people speak it. Developed the language of representation to facilitate this translation, with three-dimensional visualizations and physical models.

Made it possible for a cross-disciplinary volunteer team to gather, that includes professionals from fields such as law, planning, urban design, architecture and art. The team enabled the municipal organization, which insisted on the classical - comprehensive planning approach, to revise solid planning strategies - in this way, the zoning plan evolved into a plan with the capacity to organize participatory planning and design processes.

Facilitated many focus groups, meetings, interviews, participatory planning and design workshops for and with the people of Gülsuyu & Gülensu to oversee the feasibility of the new participatory planning framework.

Worked with volunteer architecture graduate students to convert the code and numerical language of planning standards and regulations into the spatial language of architecture so that the public could understand them.

Conducted on-site meetings for volunteer participants to learn from the existing material conditions, the quotidian relations, civic solutions to spatial challenges. After long-term design research, the team prepared an "urban design guide" that shows how the same planning code can generate both unqualified and qualified physical space standards. The guide has produced a resource that the neighborhood can use to demand better spatial solutions during the construction process, provided that it is accompanied by long-term social programs.

Designed research that adopts multimethodology to measure the perceptions and expectations of the people from the neighborhood renewal process, their capacity for public participation, their level of poverty and place attachment. Conducted a comprehensive survey with 1107 randomly selected households (95% of confidence interval, 2.5% of confidence level). Made focus group meetings with Muhtars, opinion leaders and activists from the neighborhood and in-depth interviews with randomly selected respondents from the survey's sample.

Converted survey responses into spatial data and used GIS tools for a clearer picture of the social reality as the performative capacity of people reacting to social and economic hardships in a squatter settlement. Adopted a critical realist mixed method rather than a monomethod quantitative approach that can only rely on dry data-analysis and techniques of statistical reasoning, supplemented the explanatory study by in-depth observation, comparative thinking, interpretative and interpersonal skills.

By promoting high end "prestige projects" over social housing, perpetuating the city's uncontrolled growth, destroying the city's ecological thresholds and northern forests, and forcibly relocating the urban poor through numerous "urban renewal" projects, the model has established a questionable legacy.
